1. Where was the Ottoman Empire?
2. Why might the Ottomans and the Safavids come into conflict?
3. Do you think the Mughals and the Ottomans ever fought? Explain.
4. Why do you think these three states did not unite into one large Empire?

Day 1: Map Activity. Using your own color key, shade in the 3 Muslim Empires.

Label the following: 1. EUROPE, ASIA and AFRICA.

2. Red Sea, Indian Ocean, Bay of Bengal, Nile, Tigris, Euphrates, Ganges and Indus.

3. Algiers, Tunis, Tripoli, Cairo, Athens, Adrianople, Constantinople, Damascus, Jerusalem, Medina, Mecca, Baghdad, Isfahan, Hormez and Delhi.

Discuss issues facing empire builders, cultural blending and growth of the Muslim empire.
