



Quick Reference Winter Uniform Guidelines

| Oxford Shirt | Young men and ladies | White or light blue long or short sleeved oxford with SMR logo. | Cold weather add in- can wear a long sleeve article under the oxford shirt. No hooded items are allowed. |

| Sweater 9th and 10th | Young men and ladies | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Navy blue quarter zip with SMR logo purchased from uniform store. ➤ Navy blue V-neck with SMR logo purchased from uniform store. | No hooded sweatshirts are permitted except with game day attire representing appropriate team logo from team store. |
| Sweater Vest (optional) 11th and 12th | Young men and ladies | Optional sweater vest can be worn only in conjunction with the uniform blazer. | |
| Pants | Young men and ladies | Khaki Pants with SMR logo from official uniform store. | |
| Skirt | Young ladies | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Khaki skirt with SMR logo from official uniform store. ➤ Must be fingertip length in front and back ➤ Can not be rolled. | |
| Shoes | Young men and ladies | Solid brown leather topsiders, suede bucks. | |
| Tights/Knee Socks | Young ladies | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Navy blue or solid white knee socks. ➤ Navy blue or solid white tights. ➤ White or black socks above the ankle. | |
| Socks | Young men | White or black socks above the ankle. | |
| Belt | Young men and ladies | ➤ Brown dress belt (solid, weave or khaki- canvas or leather). | |
| Inclement Weather Attire | Young men and ladies | Navy blue quarter zip with SMR logo purchased from uniform store or navy blue V-neck with SMR logo purchased from uniform store. | Personal full zip jacket can be worn over proper uniform attire on inclement days. |
| General Guidelines | Young men and ladies | The following items may not be worn and will be confiscated: sweatshirts, non-uniform sweaters, non-compliant clothing, etc.... | No hats are to be worn in school. |

Dress code:

The SMR dress code provides a standard for our students conducive to learning and respectful behavior. The SMR dress code balances the need for self-expression and promotes a positive attitude. The school uniform is a point of pride and must always be worn in an appropriate manner. In addition, students are required to follow the appropriate grooming guidelines and tag day guidelines or the student will receive appropriate disciplinary action. Students must maintain possession of their school issued student ID at all times.

Incident/Cold weather attire:

If a student is cold during the school day he/she are to wear the SMR uniform sweater, SMR uniform quarter zip, personal full zip jacket. Upperclassman (11th and 12th grade students) must wear the SMR uniform blazer at all times during the winter uniform timeframe. The following items may not be worn and will be confiscated: sweatshirts, non-uniform sweaters, non-compliant clothing, etc....

Tag day attire:

On tag days, non-uniform days, students should use good judgment and wear clothes that are modest and in good taste. If on a tag day a student is not dressed appropriately and immediate adjustments cannot be made prior to the student going to class, the parent\Guardian will be called and the student will be sent home to change attire. The time missed due to noncompliance will be unexcused and will result in loss of class credit. Guidelines for appropriate tag day attire are as follows:

- Shirts\tops-must be at least short sleeved or longer. Shirt may have a crewneck or small V-neck, no open or plunging necklines. May not be open back. Must cover the midriff and lower back areas completely whether standing or sitting. No halter tops, tube tops, strapless shirts, low-cut tops, tank tops, etc....
- Pants\slacks-must be worn at waist level and not hip level. Material must not have holes on the upper thigh pocket area. Pajama\lounge style pants are not permitted. Yoga pants are not permitted. (yoga pants, workout pants, leggings are not acceptable)
- Shorts\skirts-must be at least fingertip length or longer both in front and back

Game day attire:

Official SMR team jerseys or an item from the team store are allowed for players to wear on game days. White undershirts are required underneath basketball, tennis, or sleeveless jerseys and are optional for all other sports. SMR daily uniform pants and shorts\skirts must be worn.

Violation of dress code:

Students in violation of dress code will receive three demerits and consequences including X hour detention, after school detention, Saturday detention, suspension, requiring a parent to bring appropriate clothes to school, student sent home to change into a proper attire, or other consequences at the discretion of the Dean of Student Life. Inappropriate apparel will result in removal from class until student is dressed in proper attire.

Hair:

Hair must be natural color. For young men hair must be neatly cut above the eyebrows, above the ears, and not to touch the collar for young men. Ponytails are not permitted.
